

VENUE AND COURSE

INDIVIDUAL

55 men and 55 women will line up on the pontoon along the west side of the Pont Alexandre III bridge. Each of the two swim laps therefore begin in the direction of the potentially strong current, the first lap taking in 910m total, the second 590m. The athletes head up a ramp back onto the pontoon and dive back in between the two.

Out of the water for the second time, there are 36 stone steps up to the top of the bridge and a sharp left to transition. The seven bike laps (5.715km each) begin by heading north towards and along the Champs Elysees to a dead turn with the Arc de Triomphe in the background.

A right turn takes the athletes down Avenue Montaignes and then left to Pont des Invalides, back across the Seine and down Boulevard Saint-Germain before looping left back towards the river and the Alexandre III bridge. A total of 1.5m of each bike lap is cobbled.

The four-lap run follows a similar route, heading left down Av Montaigne without the dead turn of the bike and looping back on itself between the Pont Alexandre III and Pont de la Concorde, with 25% of each lap cobbled.

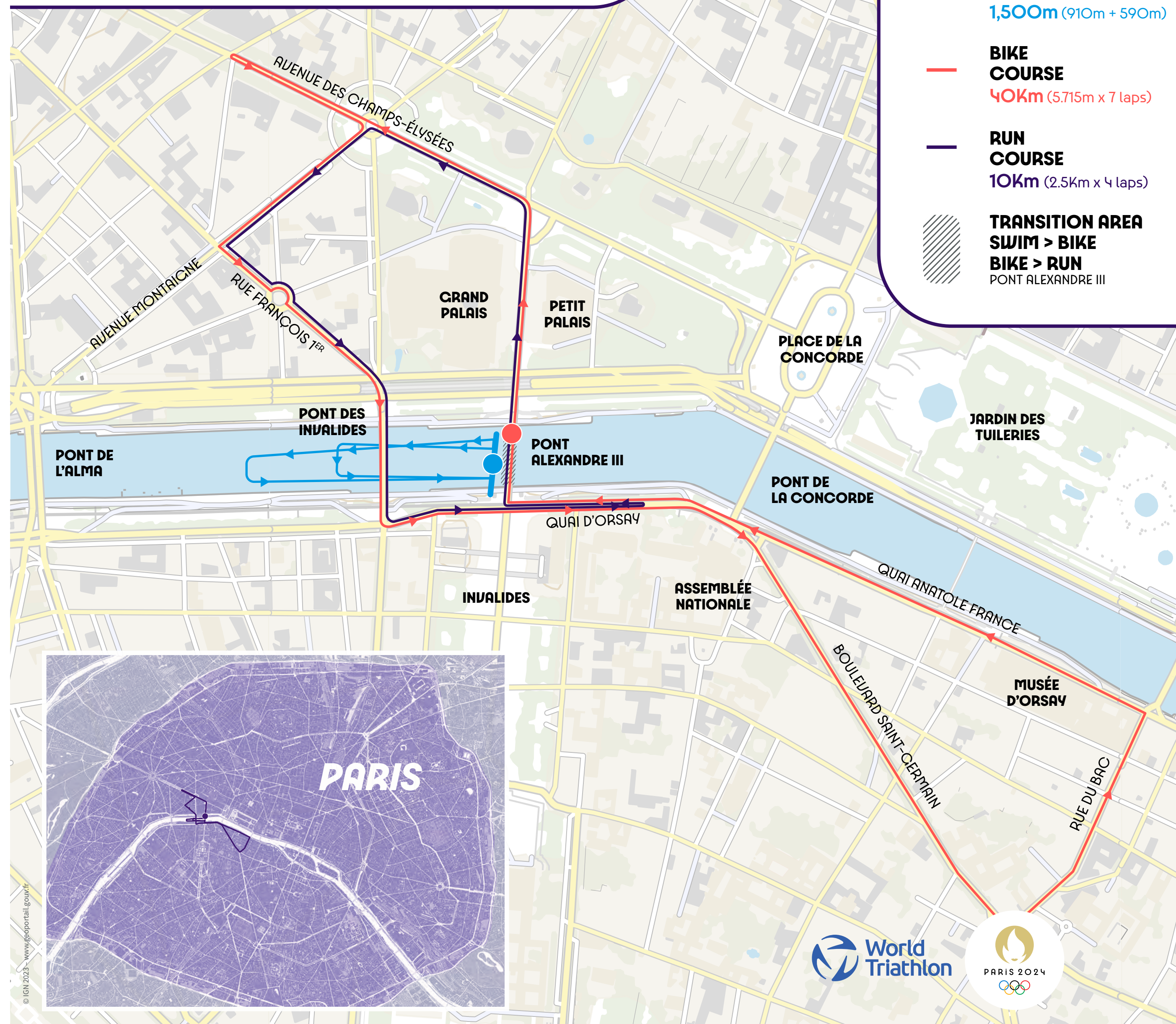

MIXED RELAY

The 16 athletes taking on the first leg of their respective team's Olympic Mixed Relay hopes will line up on the pontoon on 5 August with a one-lap, 300m swim ahead of them.

Emerging from the water, the athletes must run up the 36 steps and take a sharp left to the transition and 2 x 3.5km tight and technical bike laps, each one including 44% of cobbled surface to ride on. Off the bikes and

on to the run, it is another flat and fast 1.8km over two laps, each 38% cobbled, the second ending down the ramp to the banks of the Seine via two sharp switchbacks to the handover point.

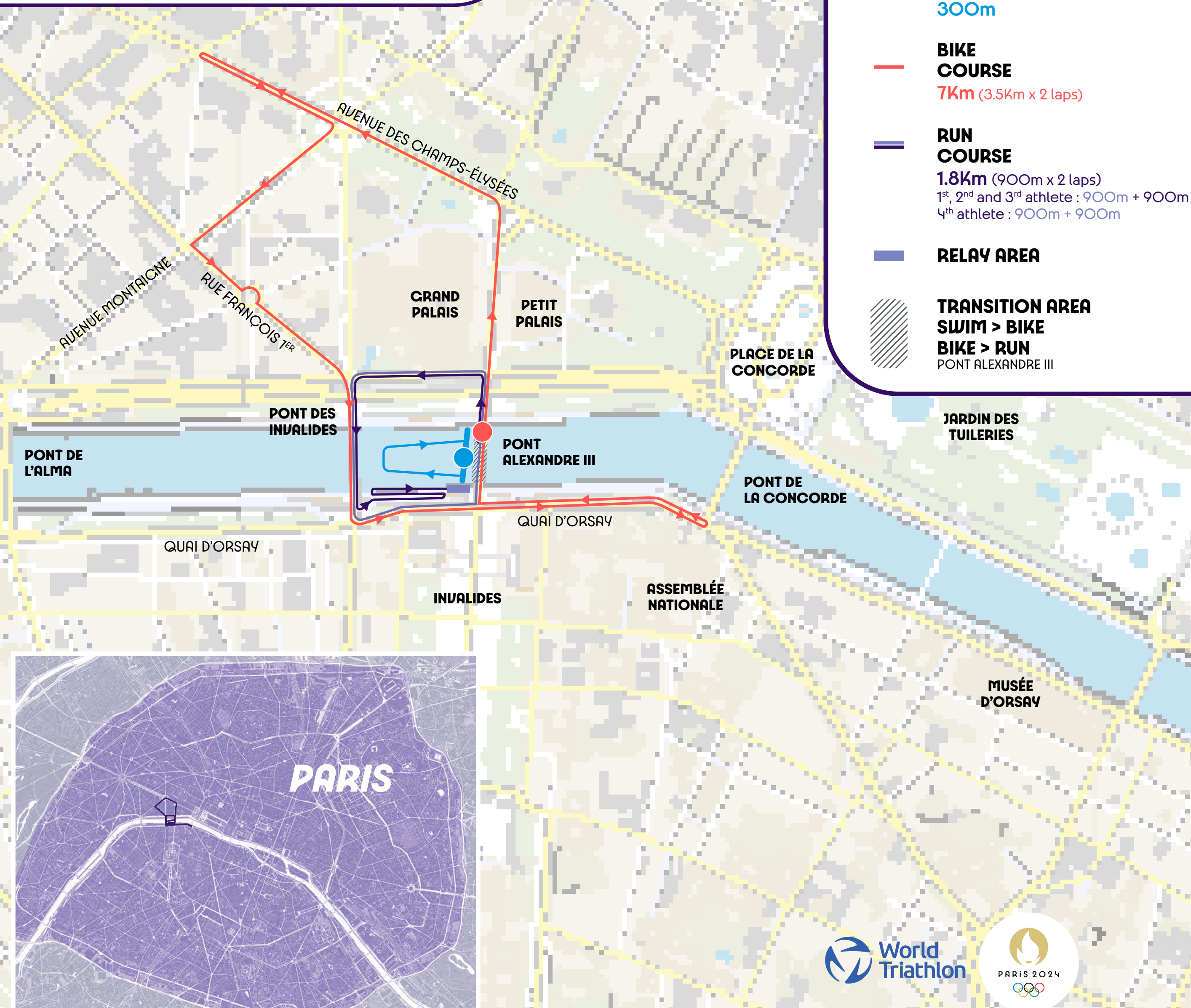
For the women taking the anchor leg, they will bypass the ramp, take the left back onto the Pont Alexandre III and hit the blue carpet, where their three Olympic Mixed Relay team members await their destiny.

Age: 31

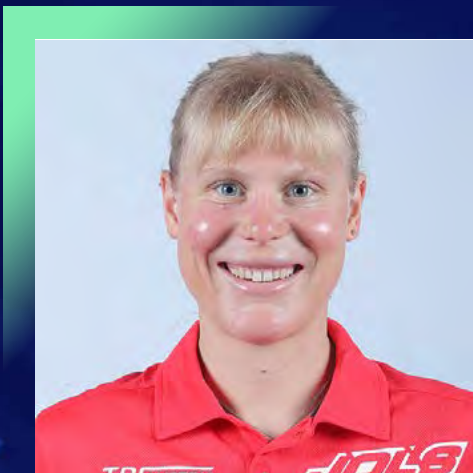

At the start of 2024 he then proved instrumental in securing relay qualification for his country with a barnstorming performance in Napier. Vilaca also won the silver medal at the Paris Olympic Test Event and as such will be one of the favourites to make the individual podium this summer.

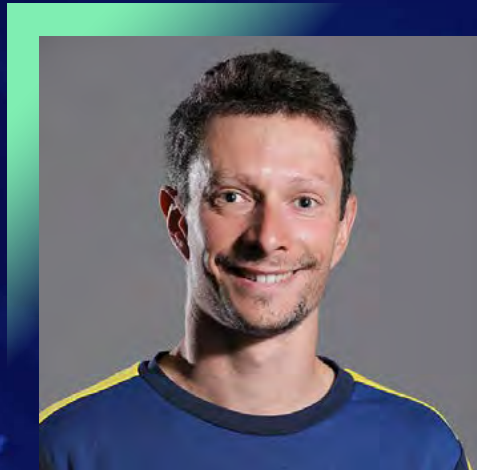

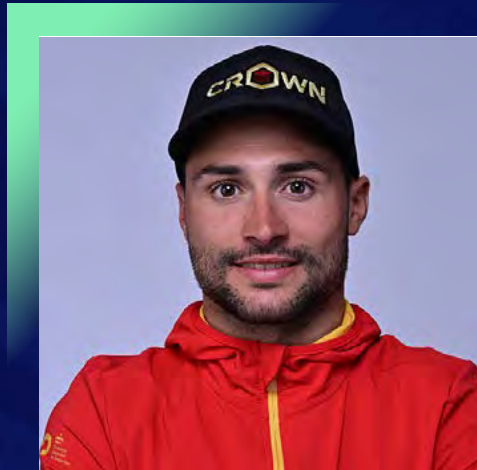
